**RULES/REGULATIONS**

- 1) This is a 36-hole, 2-person scramble event. In the 2-person scramble format both players hit tee shots, both players hit their second shots from the position of the best tee shot, and continue this process until the ball is holed. To speed play, we will employ the "2-putt maximum" rule on each hole. Team captains should fill out their scorecards each day with only the team score for each hole recorded. Scorecards should be totaled, signed, and turned in to the pro shop at the end of each round.
- 2) There is a maximum of 36 two-person teams entered in the tournament and procedures discussed herein will be based on a full field of 36 teams. If fewer than 36 teams participate, the procedures will be altered appropriately to accommodate the lesser number of teams.
- 3) The tournament will begin with a 1 p.m. shotgun start both days. Players should plan on arriving at the Clubhouse no later than 12:30 p.m. each day. Following golf Saturday evening, there will be a buffet steak dinner with a cash bar at the Golf Clubhouse. Following golf Sunday evening, there will be a buffet barbeque dinner and awards ceremony at the Golf Clubhouse.
- 4) After the scores from Saturdays round are totaled, the scores will be arranged from lowest to highest. If there are ties among the Saturday totals, they will be broken by scorecard playoff based on a "hole no. and direction" that will be drawn after play is completed Saturday. After the ties are broken and the "Saturday order of finish" is established, the 6 lowest Saturday scores will be placed in Championship flight, the next 6 in A-flight, the third 6 in B-flight, and so on through E-flight.
- 5) Teams will compete for prizes based on their 2-day total scores, and will only compete with other teams in their own flight. If there are ties in the 2-day total scores that affect the awarding of prizes, they will be broken by scorecard playoff of their Sunday scores, based on a "hole no. and direction" that will be drawn after play is completed Sunday. (Exception: A number will be drawn at the end of play Sunday; any team in A-E flights whose Sunday score improves on their Saturday score by more than the "drawn number" will be elevated into and compete against teams in the next highest flight)
- 6) During the awards ceremony accompanying dinner Sunday evening, gift certificate prizes will be awarded to the first through fourth place finishers in each of the 6 flights, as well as winners of the 4 proximity contests from each day.
- 7) Men will play from the white tees; women will play from the red tees.
- 8) Winter rules will be in effect. Lies may be improved in all areas other than greens, by a distance of not more than 1 club-length, no closer to the hole. On the greens, lies may be improved by a distance of not more than 1 putter-head length, no closer to the hole.
- 9) In addition to the team competition, there is an optional skins game each day for those who would like to participate. The entry fee for the skins game is \$10 per team per day.
