nature note

OH, SNAP! IT'S A TURTLE

The snapping turtle has a pointed head, thick tail and a small lower shell. If you run across these characters be careful because they have strong jaws and long necks (making it better to snap at you)! These turtles prefer water, including mud or submerged logs.



The aquatic turtle keeps populations in check and it's nemesis is the skunk, raccoon or mink; all of these turtle enemies are capable of destroying the seemingly irritable snapper. Snapper turtles are beneficial scavengers and they eat water plants, dead animals and crawfish. Just a reminder, these turtles will not bite unless you pick them up!
