## NATURE NOTE: Is My Lawn Still Alive? Normally, a healthy lawn can stay dormant for a good five weeks and still recover. If you are wondering if the turf is still alive, pull up an individual plant and separate the leaves from the crown. The crown is the area between the leaves and the roots. If it is still hard and not papery and dry, the plant is still alive. When rains and cooler weather arrive, the turf should come out of dormancy.
