Sulphur Butterfly

The Cloudless Sulphur Butterfly is of the large family of sulphur butterflies. Specimens are very difficult to tell apart in the field — Clouded, Cloudless, Little Yellow Sulphur. This butterfly has an irregular black border, upper forewing

with dark spot and 2 pink-edged silver spots in hindwing. You'll find them in meadows and fields and almost any open spaces, parks and pastures. These butterflies are some of the most abundant in the American Midwest. Colors vary between the male and female. These butterflies are constantly on the move, and don't stay in one place long.
