Bald Eagle Sighting at IBK

Property Owner Ed Doisy spotted a bald eagle circling over Lake



Seebrook last week. According to the Missouri Conservation Department, biologists estimate that Missouri's summer eagle population is around 300, but in the winter, the population grows almost tenfold. Bald eagles are usually observed near lakes, rivers and marshes as they forage for fish or carrion.
