




Explore the Tyrolean Trail - Find the Geo Cache!



Fishing Rules & Regulations Alpine Lake: All bass MUST be returned to Lake Alpine. NO

Alpine Lake: All bass MUST be returned to Lake Alpine. NO bass may be kept regardless of size. Crappie longer than 10" may be kept. Catfish and bluegill may also be kept with a daily limit per person (5 catfish, 10 crappie, 20 bluegill).

Other Lakes: Slot length limit on bass of 12"-16", release this size and keep fish caught outside the limit. All other fish can be kept regardless of size and reasonable quantity. Return all paddlefish. NO trotlines, bank lines and jug fishing allowed. Do not fish around swimming areas and beaches.
