<u>NATURE NOTE</u>

Acorns Begin to Fall

This is the time of year when acorns begin falling to the ground. The acorn is the fruit of the oak tree. It is a nut, usually containing a single seed, enclosed in a tough, leathery shell.

Acorns are one of the most important wildlife foods where oak trees are present. They are attractive to animals because they are large and rich in nutrients. Birds, including jays, pigeons, ducks and woodpeckers, feed on acorns, as well as mammals, such as mice, squirrels and deer. However, acorns can be toxic to other animals, such as horses. Acorns appear only on adult trees, so they are often a symbol of patience.
