GARDEN CLUB PLANT PROFILE — OSTRICH FERN

Each week until the Village of Innsbrook Garden Club's Plant Sale on May 13, we will feature a profile of one of the plants that will be available. Have a corner in your yard that's deeply shaded and damp? A spot where nothing much seems to grow? Try planting ostrich fern! Ostrich fern is easy to grow and deer tend to leave it alone. In nature, it grows in dappled shade on the forest edge or in moist soil near water, so look for a site with damp shade. Showy, arching sterile fronds are plume-like and remind us of an ostrich's tail feathers. Planting among shrubs or against a fence or wall protects the fronds from wind damage.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR THOSE WITH IRRIGATION SYSTEMS

If you have an irrigation system (and ONLY if you have an irrigation system) please make arrangements to have the backflow prevention device inspected this year and have a copy forwarded to Duke Haydon in the Innsbrook Utilities department. This is necessary even if you do not currently use your irrigation system. Your installer is normally capable of this test and it is usually done as part of the spring start-up procedure. Also, Keith Thompson (ext. 9177) in our Horticulture Department can perform the test if you prefer. If you have any questions, please contact Duke at ext. 9167.

REMINDER: PROPERTY OWNER INFORMATION OFFICE AT NEW BUILDING
