## WEEKLY BLUEBIRD REPORT

Our bluebirds are taking nesting seriously! This week we have 75 active nests, 154 eggs and 16 chicks. The female bluebird does most of the incubating. She develops a brood patch, an area of skin on her chest that is free from feathers and filled with extra blood vessels, which she presses against the eggs to warm them. Incubation usually lasts for 12-14 days. ## nature note

### HELLO HUMMINGBIRDS!

The ruby-throated hummingbird is one of Missouri's most fascinating birds. It's easy to attract these summer visitors by providing food sources for them in your yard or garden.

Plants, especially Missouri native plants, should be an important part of your plan to attract hummingbirds. Flowers supply them with the nutrient-rich nectar that can provide up to 90 percent of their diet. Ruby-throated hummingbirds especially love red or orange tubular flowers, such as those found on trumpet creeper, native honeysuckles and red buckeye.

One simple way to attract rubythroats is to build or buy a hummingbird feeder and fill it with a nectar solution. Providing a complete diet in your feeder is not essential, because the birds will balance their diets on their own. Hang the feeder where you can see it from inside your house.
