nature note

FROG SONG HERALDS SPRING

You can hear spring coming as our friendly neighborhood frogs rise up in chorus. Their voices sing clearly of warmer days.

Spring peepers and chorus frogs call from shallow breeding pools on rainy and warm spring nights. Only the males call, as they are luring females to the ponds to breed.

Spring peepers are small frogs, about the size of a quarter. Their pinkish-tan bodies have a brown, x-shaped marking on the back. Peepers are found throughout much of the eastern United States. Chances are you've heard their call as early as February.

Another spring singer is the western chorus frog, a small, gray frog with dark brown stripes. You can imitate the chorus frog's call by running your thumbnail along the small teeth of a pocket comb. Chorus frogs call on rainy nights from now through April. By late March, other kinds of frogs and toads join the nightly chorus of spring.
