NATURE NOTE

In the (Mushroom) Hunt



April showers bring...
mushrooms? April showers and
warm nights make morels
(muh-rells) grow and send folks to
their favorite mushroom-hunting
spots. In late spring, watch for
morels growing on the ground. The
top or cap looks something like a
sponge, with a shape similar to a
tiny Christmas tree. The stem is
thick, and when sliced, the whole
mushroom is hollow. Three species
are commonly found in our area, so

morels will vary in color from gray to tan or yellow. They come in a variety of sizes, but most average three to four inches tall. Like all mushrooms, morels are a fungus; and the part we pick is just the fruit, so to speak. Morels seem to pop up overnight! They usually grow in 24 to 48 hours. Look for morels in moist woods and on south-facing slopes. As with any wild edible, be sure you can identify morels before eating them! Either tag along behind an experienced morel hunter or take a good reference book along on your hunt.

PLANT PROFILE

Siberian Bugloss "Brunnera macrophylla"

In April or May you may think you are seeing forget-me-nots in your garden, but if you plant "Brunnera macrophylla" you may actually be looking at the wonderful ground-cover for shade: Siberian Bugloss. We will be offering this plant at the VIGC Spring Plant Sale on Saturday, May 9, this year. Deer and rabbit resistant, these plants have already been tested at Innsbrook. "Bugloss" from the Greek meaning "Ox tongue"!

Siberian Bugloss is a rhizomatous, clump-forming



perennial that is primarily grown in shady areas for its attractive heart-shaped, dark green, basal foliage. Small, forget-me-not-like flowers (light blue with yellow centers) bloom in airy, branched racemes rising well above the foliage on slender stems to 18" tall in spring. Basal, heart-shaped, blackish-green leaves

(3-5" wide) form a foliage mound, which remains attractive throughout the growing season. Smaller stem leaves are elliptic. USDA Plant Hardiness Zones 3-8. No serious disease problems but slugs and snails are occasional visitors.

"In my garden deer have eaten the blossoms, but never the leaves! Good news, because this woodland plant is valued for both its flowers and ground-covering leaves. Terminal clusters of delicate blue flowers appear in spring. Loves shade and a moist, well-drained soil." -Lynn Laws
