HOMEOWN MILKWEEDS FOR MONARCHS

Concern for declining monarch populations due to habitat loss — both here and on their wintering grounds in Mexico — has generated much interest in growing milkweeds, the primary plant on which monarch butterflies lay their eggs. Once the larvae hatch from the eggs, they only eat milkweed and a closely related vine, making these native plants quite popular. However, the benefits of planting milkweeds extend well beyond providing leaves for monarch caterpillars to eat. Milkweeds provide resources for many species. Their flowers are visited by a constant trail of nectar-feeders and are often covered with a host of butterflies.
