### An Adv-ants-ed Society

All ant species live in societies, and each society is headed by a queen. Some societies are complex, with many different classes or castes, but most ant species in our area have simple societies with only a few castes. Most of the population in an ant colony at any given time is female, and virtually all the work in the colony is done by them. The males live briefly and their chief function is to mate. By contrast, the females live and labor long: individual workers may live six years and queens as long as 15 years.
