NATURE NOTE Wild Grapes are Ripening

There are eight or more varieties of wild grapes in Missouri, some larger, some sweeter. Wild grapes can be found on streambanks, pond edges, roadsides, and in open woods. In woods, the vine is usually very large and has grown up a tree. Many

wildlife species relish the fruits. The grapes are a favorite food source for white-tailed deer and other wildlife including wild turkeys, raccoons, skunks, squirrels, opossums, and many types of birds. Flowers bloom from mid to late spring, and globeshaped fruits are borne in drooping clusters from late summer through fall.
