

While I liked my concept, it just didn't work, and I wasn't sure why. A little later, I was temporarily based in New York. Early one morning before sunrise, I was



riding from the Kennedy Airport, crossing the Queensborough Bridge and listening to a recording of the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra performing 'Rhapsody In Blue.' I happened to turn back to look at the nighttime Manhattan skyline. Then it hit me. 'Rhapsody' is homage to New York City. My painting had no connection to the city – no wonder it didn't work."

Snow Removal - Sign up Today!

We don't know when that first big snow is coming! Be prepared by getting your name on the list for full-season snow removal service for your driveway (automatic snow clearing with snowfalls of 3"/\$40 per service). All property owners wishing to sign up for snow removal must also sign a waiver again this year, found at **www.innsbrook-resort.com/property-owners/forms**, before you are considered to be officially on the list. Call ext. 180 to sign up. (<u>Starting in 2015</u>, if you have already signed a waiver, all you'll need to do is call to confirm you would like to remain on the list.)

NATURE NOTE

The Dark Side of Innsbrook

Going off of daylight savings time in the fall can be a bummer in that it's dark by 5 p.m. However, it also means that you can enjoy stargazing without being a night owl. Seeing the Milky Way is thankfully still quite common at Innsbrook.

Light pollution affects our night skies as well as impacts wildlife, energy consumption, and even our own health. Please consider turning off your outdoor



lights when away from Innsbrook, and point landscaping lights downward. Globe at Night is a campaign to raise awareness about light pollution by inviting people to measure their sky brightness and compare results to magnitude guides. Using the Orion constellation as a test, magnitude 1 stars are what you'd be able to see in St. Louis at the Galleria parking lot. Magnitude 7 is what you'd see with the naked eye on top of a isolated mountain in a desert. Innsbrook is somewhere in between.
