NATURE NOTE

The Year of the Acorn and Hickory Nut

"I walk the roads of Innsbrook most every day and let me say that this is the year of the acorn and the hickory nut. The roads were covered with all different kinds of them. One type of hickory nut I saw had a very thin husk and a thin shell. I ate a piece of the kernel and it was like eating a green persimmon and left a bitter taste.

When I got home I got out my "Trees of Missouri" and learned a few things. There are seven kinds of hickories in our area. They are Black, Shellbark (Kingnut), Shagbark, Pignut, Mockernut, Bitternut, and Pecan. The nut that I tasted was a Bitternut and is considered inedible. Also, I didn't know that the pecan is part of the Hickory family (Carya) and the Shellbark tree produces Missouri's largest hickory nut. There are many hickory trees here but the Shagbark is easiest to spot since, as the name implies, its bark is shaggy." - *Innsbrook property owner Ralph Hoer. FarmMade.com photo.*
