THE HOLIDAY TREE THIEF

You might steal a kiss under its green branches, but in nature, mistletoe is a parasitic plant that attaches to and steals nutrients from trees. It's not a complete parasite as its leaves can convert sunshine into energy. And it's not a complete bum as its flowers, fruits and leaves provide many benefits.

The white berries that you see around Christmas are toxic to humans and some animals, but provide food when it's scarce for mammals like deer, elk, squirrels and chipmunks. Chickadees, bluebirds, robins and other birds eat the berries and spread the sticky seeds in their droppings or by wiping them off on branches.

Mistletoe grows naturally in southern Missouri in clumps high up on trees. It's rare in Missouri but can be found in river valleys on sycamore, elm, river birch and oaks. It grows in tangled balls as much as five feet across.

Mistletoe is a beneficial parasite that feeds and shelters wildlife and fills our homes with greenery and joy during the holidays!
