nature notes

If you're looking for an adventure during the cold winter, consider volunteering for the Christmas Bird Counts. This is an annual tradition from Friday, December 14 through Saturday, January 5 where birders and scientists count all the birds seen or heard from sunrise to after sunset. Anyone can join and new counters may be paired with experienced bird watchers. It's a great way to learn more about birds and help them at the same time. Conservationists gather the data to learn where birds are and what new birds are migrating to other areas.

This tradition was started in 1900 on Christmas Day. This is the longest running science effort in the United States. Visit <http://bit.ly/Christmasbirdcount> to learn more about the Christmas Bird Count.
