## Innsbrook news

### GUN RANGE UPDATE, QUARRY MEETING THURSDAY

In a 2-1 decision, the Warren County commissioners approved the conditional use permit (CUP) with added restrictions for the gun range/training facility in a quarry west of Innsbrook. The permit allows for 40 days of use (down from 60), five of which may be Saturdays (down from 10), and does not allow training on Sundays or holidays. The hours of permitted use were also shortened to 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. (originally 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.). The group must also notify the Warren County Sheriff of the days and times they will be on property. Possible next steps are being considered, look for an update when more information is available.

In a related matter, the CUP for BMC Stone to operate the same site as a quarry is up for renewal with Warren County Planning and Zoning (separate from the gun range/training facility) and will be discussed Thursday, December 20 at 7 p.m. at 101 Mockingbird Ln. in Warrenton. BMC is asking for no renewal term (the current CUP was for 10 years) and no noise abatement. In partnership with our neighbors surrounding the quarry, we support a five-year renewal term, noise and operational restrictions and that the board retain the additional conditions set forth in the current CUP. Property owners are encourage to attend and wear green. Ext. 9180.

## nature notes

Have you noticed a new unidentified bird flying around the birdfeeder?

The new bird may be the American Goldfinch. In the winter after the goldfinchs are finished molting, the males' feathers grow back a pale, subdued yellow. Sometimes their change in feathers is so different they are mistaken for a different species. By March, they'll return to their brilliant yellow color with black wings.



American Goldfinches molt twice a year. The females also replace their feathers but they have a muted color throughout the year, with their upper body being a greenish-yellow color. The feathers provide insulation, water repellency and protection from the sun. The change in feather color helps the birds blend into their surroundings and attract partners.

If you're having challenges identifying these birds in the winter, the short, conical bill separates it from the warblers.

The survival of goldfinches is linked to thistles and other composite-family flowers as the birds feed their young thistle seeds. This is an unusual diet for nestlings, because most small birds feed their young insects, a concentrated source of protein.

These beautiful birds are joyfully received when their feathers change back to bright yellow signifying a sign that spring will be at IBK soon. Look for the next change around March!
