DON'T TRUST THE SWATCH!

Paint is a great way to give any desired space an easy and relatively inexpensive makeover! However, you shouldn't just rely on that little paint swatch to ensure the color(s) you've selected will work. Paint will portray different hues depending on how much natural light is present, what type of light bulbs are in use, what other colors are within the space and so on. Luckily, most paint stores have 8-16 oz. paint samples that can be mixed to any color you choose for less than \$10 a piece! So, before you order enough paint for the entire space, start off with a sample(s) to brush along the wall and review the color at different times throughout the day.

nature note

THE ARMADILLO ARMY MARCHES NORTH

The nine-banded armadillo primarily eats insects and their larvae as well as earthworms, spiders and other invertebrates. Their habit of digging and rooting for food, in addition to excavating burrows to bear their young, can lead to conflicts with property owners. Armadillos destroy harmful insects, but their digging can be a nuisance

around gardens and homes. Armadillos can carry the slow-moving leprosy bacterium, but there have been no armadillo-transmitted leprosy cases in Missouri. As a precaution, wear gloves if you must handle armadillos, alive or dead.

The sudden and extremely rapid armadillo colonization of new areas of the U.S. has puzzled quite a few biologists. The degree of range expansion per year is nearly ten times faster than the average rate expected for a mammal.

Factors that have influenced the armadillo expansion northward include decreased hunting pressure by humans, a decrease in other predators due to human activity and development, and the deliberate or accidental release of captive armadillos. Armadillos have a high reproductive rate, so it only takes a small number to establish stable populations in new areas.

Further expansion is unlikely, as armadillos have very little body fat and do not conserve heat well. They cannot establish stable colonies if the average January temperature is below 28°F. Learn more at www.armadillo-online.org.
