nature notes

PREPARE FOR PURPLE MARTINS

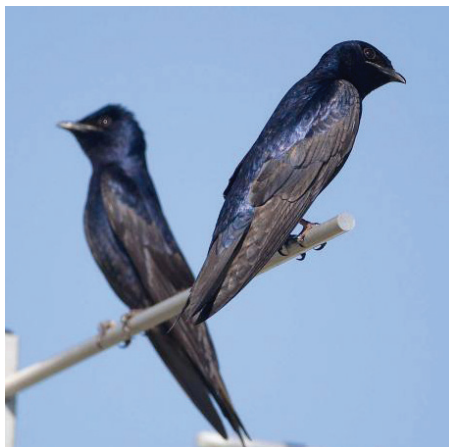
Here in the heartland, Missourians have a long tradition as purple martin landlords, which is something to be proud of because these beautiful birds need our help to survive!

These aerial acrobats catch flying insects on the wing. However, they are not major predators of mosquitoes, which fly much lower than martins do. A

martin colony, however, may catch and eat several hundred beetles, horseflies, grasshoppers, dragonflies and wasps each day.

These glossy gliders spend the cold months in South America and begin arriving in Missouri in early March. Because of this, they can be confronted with life-threatening weather conditions. Cold rains may eliminate flying insects, the main source of martins' food. During bad weather some landlords place thawed crickets, meal worms and cooked eggs on elevated platforms or even fling the food into the air using a slingshot or large plastic spoon. You can help purple martins survive by erecting and maintaining nest boxes or gourds on your Innsbrook property. Find plans at www.mdc.mo.gov.
