INNSBROOK HISTORICAL SOCIETY UPDATES

Restoration Work on the Schoolhouse is Underway

Near the end of 2017, the Innsbrook Historical Society (IHS) began work on a new project — the historic schoolhouse!



The Upper Charrette Schoolhouse, which is located a short distance inside Innsbrook's west gate, was originally opened in 1881, rebuilt in 1909, closed in 1941 and restored in 2000. It has good bones, but the exterior and interior are in bad shape. IHS volunteers are planning to deconstruct the schoolhouse and move it in sections to a spot on the grounds of the historic log cabin site, where they will rebuild it and restore the exterior and interior.



During deconstruction, the volunteers plan to reclaim as much of the original interior wood as possible to use in the restoration. Anyone interested in helping with this project is welcome! IHS is also very interested in capturing some of the personal history of the schoolhouse. If you know anyone who may have attended or taught at the school please let them know, as they hope to create an oral history. Go to www.innsbrookhistoricalsociety.org for more information.

THE MASKED BANDIT OF THE NIGHT

There is one type of masked bandit that Innsbrook's gates can't keep out and Security can't contain — raccoons! Bandit-masked raccoons are a familiar sight just about everywhere because they will eat just about anything. They are adaptable and use their dexterous front paws and long fingers to find and feast on a wide variety of fare.

In the natural world, raccoons snare a lot of their meals in the water. These nocturnal foragers use lightning-quick paws to grab crayfish, frogs and other aquatic creatures. On land, they pluck mice and insects from their hiding places and raid nests for tasty eggs. This trash-diving omnivore's taste is anything but discriminating!

Females have one to seven cubs in early summer. The young raccoons often spend the first two months or so of their lives high in a tree hole. Later, mother and children move to the ground, where the cubs begin to explore on their own.

There are actually several other species of raccoons in addition to the familiar northern (North American) raccoon. Most other species live on tropical islands!
