NATURE NOTE

Squirrels - Friend or Foe - You Decide!



There are more than 365 species of squirrels in seven families. They include the tree squirrel, ground squirrel and flying squirrel, plus many squirrel-like mammals such as the gopher, ground hog and prairie dog. Squirrels are most active in late winter, when the mating season begins. Males will chase females, as well as other suitors, at break-neck speeds through the trees while they

perform some of the most breathtaking acrobatics imaginable. Gray squirrels come in many colors. Shades of gray and brown are most common, but there are also pure white and pure black variations of the gray squirrel. Gray squirrels have been known to build nests in unusual places, including attics, automobiles and barbecue grills. It certainly is a challenge to keep squirrels away from your bird feeders. Try hanging a separate feeder for the squirrels away from the bird feeders.
