





WEEKLY BLUEBIRD REPORT

We presently have 51 active bluebird nests containing 85 eggs and 77 chicks. Twenty-eight more chicks have fledged, making a total of 473 fledglings so far this year. If you see a bird with his beak open and he appears to be panting, do not be alarmed. Birds cannot sweat, so in this hot weather they pant (like your dog or cat) to cool off. nature note

WILD FRUITS OF SUMMER

Wildlife and people enjoy the tastes of wild fruits in the summer. A bucket, hiking boots and some insect repellent will help you get ready for picking. Mulberries are among the first fruits of the season, ripening from late May through July. Birds and squirrels love them, so you'll find the trees full with fruit and song. They're also a favorite of children, whose blue-stained hands and faces show the fruit's juicy taste. Mulberries make fine pies and cobblers. A fruit that's often picked when it's still green is the gooseberry. The unripened fruit is tangy and makes terrific pies. The ripe fruit is red and sweet and it's hard to beat the birds to them. Gooseberries are found June through September in open woods and along roadsides. Blackberries are perhaps the all-time favorite summer wild fruit for raccoons, squirrels, box turtles, birds and people. Ripening in late June through August, blackberries are great fresh, in pies and as toppings. Look for their briar patches in prairies, old fields and along wooded edges. Be sure to know what you are picking and respect private property as you enjoy wild fruits this summer!
