nature note

JUMPING OAK GALL

Do you ever look out at your wooded lot and exclaim "Oak, no!?" If your oak trees are turning brown and dropping leaves, they may be affected by jumping oak galls. Galls form on the underside of leaves and are caused by high populations of a very tiny, native, stingless wasp. According to the Missouri Department of Conservation, these galls rarely cause significant damage to trees, although they are unattractive. Nearly all trees will recover, even if all its leaves are brown. Controls are not warranted. By the time the damage is observed, any opportunity to treat has already passed for that year, and populations are likely to decline naturally.



Good growing conditions and sanitation helps to minimize the severity of jumping oak gall infestations. This includes watering during droughty weather, proper mulching practices, being careful not to damage the bark while mowing and trimming and fertilizing trees in the spring. It's also a good idea to remove fallen leaves and compost them.
