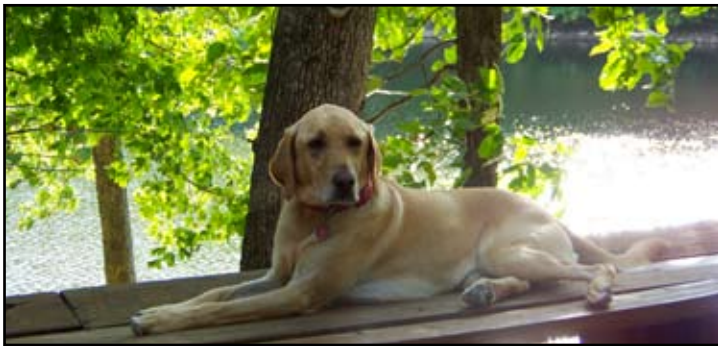

# NATURE NOTE



## Slender Mountain Mint

While your out exploring trails at Innsbrook, keep an eye out for slender mountain mint, blooming June through September. All parts of the plant have a strong mint scent; some say it smells like sage. Despite its name, this plant

usually occurs in dry, open rocky woods, dry prairies and fields, along roadsides, streambanks and in open, wet thickets. A long list of insects are attracted to the flowers: bees, wasps, flies, butterflies, skippers, beetles and bugs. Oddly, the minty taste that makes the plant attractive to humans is a turnoff to herbivorous mammals, which generally leave this plant alone.
