This week, we have 42 bluebird nests containing 71 eggs and 72 chicks. Forty-three more chicks have fledged. Check your nest boxes for ventilation holes. If the eggs or chicks are warmer than 107 degrees Fahrenheit, they will not survive. Ventilation holes should be drilled on the sides of the boxes near the top. These stickers do not expire and your existing boat sticker is still valid. Each sticker is \$5. CAUTIONARY TAIL

Deer are a treasured (and sometimes frequent) sight for many at Innsbrook and across the Midwest. You may have noticed fawns in the area. Spring is generally the time of year when deer give birth; fawns arrive between April through July. In the summer, white-tailed deer are reddish brown to tan and in the winter their colors change and fawns lose their spots.

Deer have an average lifespan of 15 years and are often essential to the environment in that their food source is often buds and branches, helping to reduce overgrowth in the plants.

Please be cautious and watch for deer on the roads throughout the year as some may walk in front of cars and can be difficult to see prior to being right in front of a vehicle.
