THE BUZZ ABOUT THE LEAFCUTTER BEE

This gentle bee is common from late spring to early autumn. These insects stand out by exclusively carrying pollen dry and on the underside of their abdomen. To recognize where leafcutter bees have been, look for holes in leaves of plants.



These are solitary bees that don't live in hives. These bees are important to pollinating sunflowers and rescue alfalfa by pollinating.
