

# **NATURE NOTE**

# **Fascinating Fireflies**

In the pitch blackness of a moonless night, fireflies appear as blinking jewels over lawns and meadows. Fireflies' light is produced by a chemical reaction in the rear underside of the firefly's body. The firefly uses its light in courtship and mating. Most fireflies you see are males, since they are signaling in flight.



Females signal from less visible perches on or near the ground. If a female of the same species recognizes the male's flashing code, she signals back. The fireflies continue to signal each other until the male finds the female. Unlike a light bulb, the fireflies' light is cool. All of the energy goes to make light and no energy is wasted as heat. A surprising number of creatures possess the firefly's ability to make light. These animals include many fish, squids, worms and bacteria. In addition, certain kinds of algae, fungi and other insects are able to make light. Fortunately, we can enjoy the firefly's cool light in our own parks and yards.
