NATURE NOTE

Poison Ivy, Oak & Sumac

Poison Ivy (*Toxicodendron radicans*):

Climbing vine with three serrated-edge, pointed leaves; color varies with the season; smooth, waxy berries. Poison ivy is a nuisance to people, but it provides considerable wildlife value. The berries are a popular food for songbirds and many birds feed on insects hiding in the tangled vines. Small mammals and deer browse on the foliage, twigs and berries.



Poison Oak (*Toxicodendron toxocarium*):

Three leaves; unlike poison ivy, both sides of all three leaflets of poison oak have distinct notches. The surest way to positively identify poison oak is by its seeds and berries, which are hairy. The seeds are yellow to cream color and grow on stalks like grapes. Poison oak is rare in most parts of Missouri, and is not found in Innsbrook.



Poison Sumac (*Toxicodendron vernix*):

A shrub or bush with two rows of 7 to 13 leaflets; most common in the peat bogs of the Northern U.S. and in swampy Southern regions of the country. Poison sumac is NOT found anywhere in Missouri.

Fourth of July Etiquette

Here are some things to keep in mind to ensure that Innsbrook's Independence Day weekend celebration is safe and fun for all!

- Please carpool when possible
- Golf carts are encouraged
- Pre-register ALL guests through Security (ext. 400; prior to Fourth of July weekend - the rush of last minute guest authorizations can quickly overwhelm the Main Gate)
- Please pick up after yourselves and take home what you bring with you to the show (including trash)
- Do not set out chairs Saturday morning
- No underage golf cart drivers
- Please do not sit on the golf course greens or tee boxes - it damages the surfaces
- No personal fireworks. All personal fireworks will be confiscated by Security.
- Slow down and relax! You're on Innsbrook time now.

Flag Rules and Regulations

One of our property owners asked us to send out a reminder on federal rules concerning the display and disposal of the American flag: The flag may be flown 24/7 only if it is properly lighted, and should be taken down during a storm. If on the same staff with other flags, the American flag should be on top. It should never touch the ground or be used for clothing or covers. Disposal should be one of two ways: 1) Given to a local VFW post for disposal or 2) Folded, saluted/pledged and burned on a hot fire. If you have a flag that needs disposal, please drop it off at the PMB and we will make sure that it's properly disposed of.
