Within 24 hours of registration, you will receive one email per guest vehicle with their unique entry ticket attached. We recommend that you simply forward (via email) each ticket to the corresponding guest. It's important that each guest uses *their unique ticket* to enter, as the barcode printed on each pass may only be scanned once for entry. Additional instructions will also be printed on each ticket.

All guests must be registered for the show by end of day, Thursday, June 30. This entry process is only for guests that are arriving on the day of the show. Any guests that will arrive or leave on other days should follow the normal guest authorization process.
