#### *Astilbe chinensis* — 'Vision in Pink'

One of the plants that will be available for sale at the Innsbrook Garden Club Plant Sale is Astilbe, Vision in Pink variety. It is deer- and rabbit-resistant. Vision has better drought tolerance than most astilbes, but they still do best with uniformly moist soils.



Astilbe will be showy in your early summer shade garden. They bloom for four weeks or more and attract hummingbirds and butterflies. ### WHEN BIRDS GET WET

Have you ever seen a bird foraging in the rain and wondered why it isn't soaked to the bone? While every bird wears one feather coat, different kinds of feathers – and even different parts of the same feather – can perform various functions.



The outermost tips of the main body feathers, called the contour feathers, are built so that the feather surface forms a fine, breathable but water-resistant mesh. This water-repellent property allows the downy bases of the same contour feathers, and other completely downy feathers, to stay dry underneath, allowing them to trap warm air. Don't you wish we had such warm, dry, light, great-looking coats?
