They started with 12 boxes made and monitored by Bob Goulding, John Hachtel and others. Twenty-three years later Bob and John are still monitors! Thanks, guys! We now have over 125 boxes that are checked weekly by 16 dedicated monitors. Last year we fledged 593 bluebird chicks. If you would like to join in the fun, boxes, poles, baffles, etc. can be purchased at Wild Birds Unlimited stores. Reports consist of four things: The number of active nests, total number of eggs, total number of chicks and the number of chicks that have fledged that week. GARDEN CLUB PLANT PROFILE – BEAR'S BREECHES

This plant is winter hardy to USDA zones 7-10, where it is easily grown in average, fertile, medium moisture, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade to full shade.
