WEEKLY BLUEBIRD REPORT

There are 85 active bluebird nests this week containing 154 eggs and 189 chicks. We've had 12 more chicks fledge. You can tell the age of your chicks by the parents' behavior. If the parents go into the box to feed and leave without fecal sacs (bird dirty diapers), the chicks are one-to-five days old. If they go into the box, feed and return with fecal sacs, they are six to 12 days old. If they just dip their heads in to feed, the chicks are 12-18 days old. They are nestlings for 16-21 days.
