This year, we'll gather to celebrate 48 wonder-filled, one-of-a-kind years at Innsbrook, surrounded by family, friends and friends who might as well be family at Charrette Creek Commons on Saturday, May 25 from 2-5 p.m. Whether you've been to the party before or are new to Innsbrook, you'll enjoy the laid-back, county fair-style atmosphere!

Registration — May 8 was the official cut-off to register for the Memorial Day Anniversary Party so that we could provide a number to the caterer. However, you and your family are still welcome to attend and we will do our best to accommodate everyone. Please consider packing a picnic lunch or cooler of snacks and drinks. **Advance name tag pickup:** Skip the registration line by picking up your name tags at Charrette Creek Commons Thursday, May 23, 3-7 p.m. or Friday, May 24, noon-8 p.m.

If you do not pick up your tags early, you must check in at the registration table upon arrival to the party. If you have picked up your name tags already, you may proceed past registration to get your cups.

Tents — Personal pop-up tents will be allowed in a designated area at the party. Only tents may be dropped off at Charrette Creek Commons on Saturday, May 25 between 10 a.m. and noon. All tents must be set up by 12:15 p.m. and must be properly secured to the ground with stakes. Tents without stakes will not be accepted. Note: Innsbrook is not responsible for lost or stolen items and personal items not removed by 6 p.m. will be moved to lost and found.

Provided Tent — A large tent will be provided near the food for shaded seating if you choose not to bring a personal tent. Please be respectful of this area and share with your neighbors as space is limited.

Pool Parking — Pool-goers, please plan to park in the regular party-going parking. The asphalt lot is reserved for handicap only. Violators will be towed.

No Parking — All of the roads near the intersection of Farmhouse Dr., Meadow Valley Dr. and Arlberg Pass will be no parking zones.

Please, No Pets — We love our animals at Innsbrook! However, with a party of this size, we ask that for the safety of party-goers and your pets to please leave them at home.

Snacks — Snacks available at the party will include grilled chicken, all-beef hot dogs, barbecued baked beans, coleslaw and refreshing sliced watermelon. We will have water and lemonade available, but you're welcome to bring coolers of whatever beverages or treats you enjoy! Bring along blankets and lawn chairs for your family picnic!

Building Closure — The Fitness Center and laundry facility will be closed during the Anniversary Party (from 2 to 5 p.m.). Please plan accordingly.

- There will be golf cart parking. Please follow signs to the designated area.

- Handicap parking will be available. Please have your handicap tag plainly displayed as you approach the party and security will direct you to the designated parking area.

- Party guests ages 21-and-over who plan to drink beer at the event **MUST** show a valid ID at the beer stamp table near the registration area. There will also be margaritas for sale.
- Restrooms are available at the Summerhaus and portapotties are available near the beer truck.
- Be sure to let you family know that there is a Lost Parents Station near the playground. It's a great place to meet if you get separated.
- All Innsbrook common ground is a smoke-free environment. This includes smoking, vaping, etc. Please be considerate of other guests and remind your family and guests.
