nature note

THE NORTHERN BOBWHITE

The northern bobwhite quail is a small, chicken-like bird that is typically seen running across the ground. It has a small, round head with a slight crest. Its round body has a very short tail. It's a reddish and brown bird with a pale throat and eye stripe (male), which is buff in the female. There are 22 subspecies of the northern bobwhite.

You definitely won't mistake its call. It's a loud, ringing "b, bob white!" You might also hear a clear, "hoy-poo." Though distinctive, the call is mimicked by a number of other bird species.

Northern bobwhites eat mostly anthropod prey as well as lush vegetation and prefer fields, grasslands, roadsides and wooded edges for habitat.

They are relatively shy and elusive. When threatened, they will crouch and freeze, relying on their camouflage to stay undetected. They will flush into low flight if they get disturbed. They are generally solitary and are sometimes found in pairs early in the year. Family groups are common in the late summer and winter roosts may have two dozen or more birds in a single covey.

Keep an eye out (or better yet, an ear out) for these interesting birds this season.

Birdie Passes are just \$269 plus tax when purchased by Thursday, November 30! After that, the price will increase to \$299 plus tax.
