BOATS MUST BE REMOVED FROM ALL COMMON AREAS THIS WEEK

Thursday, November 30

All boats must be removed from all marinas, beaches and common areas by Thursday, November 30. Do you need help with removal? Innsbrook will move your boats for you for \$50 per small boat, plus \$30 each additional boat and \$120 per pontoon boat. It is the owner's responsibility to make sure the boat is ready for removal (in the water, not dry docked, etc.). Do you want Innsbrook to store your boat for you? We can do that, too! The cost is \$150 for pontoons and \$50 for small boats. *Boats not removed from marinas, beaches and common areas by Friday, December 1 will be removed by Innsbrook with double the fee to the owner.* Ext. 9163.
