Thursday, November 30

All boats must be removed from all marinas, beaches and common areas by Thursday, November 30. Do you need help with removal? Innsbrook will move your boats for you for \$50 per small boat, plus \$30 each additional boat and \$120 per pontoon boat. It is the owner's responsibility to make sure the boat is ready for removal (in the water, not dry docked, etc.). Do you want Innsbrook to store your boat for you? We can do that, too! The cost is \$150 for pontoons and \$50 for small boats. *Boats not removed by Friday, December 1 will be removed by Innsbrook with double the fee to the owner.* Ext. 9163.

HEALTHY DEER HERE

November is prime mating season for white-tailed deer. They are magnificent creatures and a common sight across Missouri's landscape. It's hard to believe there was a time when people would travel for miles just to glimpse a deer track. It's relatively easy to see deer today, but around 100 years ago, they were hard to spot.



From a recorded low of 400 in the early twentieth century, there are around 1.42 million white-tails that roam the state today.

Biologists today work with hunters and landowners to maintain healthy deer populations and manage threats from disease.

The biggest threat is Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD), which infects members of the deer family and is always fatal. Without management intervention, the disease grows in prevalence and spreads over time and once well-established, it is impossible to eliminate. As it spreads, it can reduce deer numbers and impact wildlife watching, property values, and local and state economies. Innsbrook is located in a CWD management zone, where the Missouri Department of Conservation has implemented a deer-feeding ban, so we can do our part to help stop the spread and continue to view healthy, beautiful deer.
