PETITION FOR PROPOSED GUN RANGE

Thank you for the tremendous response to our petition opposing the permit for a proposed gun range/club just south of Innsbrook. Nearly 1,500 concerned citizens, both Innsbrook property owners and our neighbors outside our gate, signed. The petition and comments were sent to each member of the Warren County Planning and Zoning Commission. Ext. 9180.

GOLF COURSE IMPROVEMENTS TO BEGIN

Innsbrook has invested significantly in recent years to improve the golf course, Clubhouse and the overall golf experience. We'll take another huge step forward starting this month and continuing into 2019 with the final phase of a five-year, more than \$3 million investment in tees, greens, fairways, equipment and management.

Improvements include:

- **New state-of-the-art Toro irrigation system** installation beginning in November. This double-row system replaces the existing single-row system and will allow for irrigation in the rough and customized water management around green complexes. The high-density polyethylene pipe that will be used has a 50-year life span and fewer joints to lessen the possibility of leaks.
- **New Club Car Tempo golf carts** arriving in early 2019. The new platinum-colored carts with black roofs will feature USB ports and cart-mounted sand bottles to fill divots.
- **Ten remaining cart paths will be overlaid** beginning in late spring 2019, weather permitting.
- **Expanded and laser-leveled driving range tee box** will allow for additional hitting space for better turf conditions throughout the season and the improved tee box will no longer point players towards the woods. Work is scheduled to begin in spring 2019. For more information, stop by the Pro Shop. Ext. 9203.
