BOAT REMOVAL DEADLINE


Friday, November 30

PROPERTY OWNER ART SHOW: ARTIST HIGHLIGHT

The Property Owner Art Show is now open at Charrette Creek Commons. One of the artists whose work is featured in the show is Tom Berger.

Tom has several years of photography experience. Although this is his first Innsbrook Art Show, Tom has taken photos around Innsbrook throughout the years with his trustee sidekick, Snickers, a black and white fiberglass cow. He enjoys capturing beauty through his lens around Innsbrook (pictured above right) and wherever he travels.

Another artist whose work is featured in the show is Bob Goulding.



Bob discovered turned wooden bowls almost 30 years ago in a gallery in the artists' colony of Mendocino, California. He was so taken by them that his wife gave him a wood lathe for Christmas that year and he began to learn how to turn. Bob

prefers simple, elegant shapes highlighting the natural color and grain of the wood. His bowls take many shapes and forms and each one is unique. Many of Bob's bowls are made from the beautiful native woods of Missouri including cherry, walnut, cedar, maple and oak. He also works with the exotic California burls including redwood, manzanita and big leaf maple. The look, feel and smell of the wood makes it an extremely satisfying medium in which to work.

Recently, Bob also has begun to work in clay. To him, this is an interesting new concept to create things he cannot do with wood on the lathe. His pieces have been featured in several juried art gallery shows in the recent years. He has lived and worked in Innsbrook for more than 30 years.

One of Bob's submissions to the show (pictured above left) is called "Natural Edged Bowl."

The art show is open through December 10. Ext. 9180.

nature notes

THE GREAT BLUE HERON

The great blue heron has been spotted throughout Innsbrook near our lakes. Sometimes these birds are mistakenly called a crane, but the difference may be seen in flight, when their long legs stretch straight and its neck pulls back to form an S. These



magnificent fowls have an extensive slate-blue body, long legs and a slender neck. Their grace and style are noticeable. By walking slowly, they often snag prey from the lake. Although they are known as being fishers, they also dine on mice, insects and other small creatures.

Hérons are capable of flying 20 to 30 miles an hour. They are loners when they hunt and nest in colonies called rookeries. Their eggs are often preyed on by other predators. These birds are only aggressive when cornered.

If you see a breeding colony, stay back because the chicks can suffer fatal accidents in their hurry to escape.
