

MARK YOUR CALENDAR! BOAT REMOVAL DEADLINE - NOVEMBER 30

Thankfully, we still have beautiful boating weather ahead this fall. However, here is a date to mark on your calendar: All boats must be removed from all marinas, beaches and common areas by Wednesday, November 30. Need help with removal? Innsbrook will move your boats for you for \$35 per small boat, plus \$20 each additional boat, and \$100 per pontoon boats. Do want Innsbrook to store your boat for you? We can do that, too! The cost is \$100 for pontoons and \$50 for small boats. *Boats not removed by Thursday, December 1 will be removed by Innsbrook with double the fee to the owner.* Ext. 9163.

nature note-

Predicting the peak of fall color can be difficult. Missouri is blessed with a great variety of trees, shrubs, and vines. Their leaves turn at different times, so Missourians enjoy a fall color season that may last four to six weeks. The peak of fall color in Missouri is usually around mid-



October. This is when maples, ashes, oaks and hickories are at the height of their fall display. Normally by late October, the colors are fading and the leaves beginning to drop from the trees. Innsbrook is still in the early stages of the 2016 fall color season, but with the cooler nights we're now experiencing, more drastic changes will likely be underway soon.
