NATURE NOTE

Why The Leaves Change Color

Tree leaves contain cells that create food for the whole tree. Those cells use chlorophyll, which gives leaves their green color. Even though green is what you see during the growing season, there are hidden colors in the leaves called carotenoids - the same pigments that make carrots orange and corn and



daffodils yellow. In the fall, shorter days and cooler nights mean there is less energy for food-making and the chlorophyll starts to break down. The green disappears and the yellow carotenoids can finally be seen in such trees as hickory, ash, birch, maple, sycamore, cottonwood, and sassafras.
