Nature note

MILLIPEDES VS. CENTIPEDES: DO YOU KNOW THE DIFFERENCE?

Both millipedes and centipedes are arthropods, a class of jointed-legged invertebrate animals that also includes spiders. Both are found throughout the state of Missouri, and their names are somewhat misleading: centipedes have roughly 15 pairs of long legs, not hundreds, or even one hundred, while millipedes have hundreds - but not thousands- of legs.

A lot of the similarities between the two end there, though. Millipedes typically eat decaying matter, like rotting leaves, and are a vital part of the process of recycling nutrients in our environment. The decayed plant matter they consume is transformed into millipede flesh, and is then consumed by larger predators who eat millipedes!

On the other hand, centipedes are carnivorous. Unlike slow-moving round-bodied millipedes, who are secretive and like to hide in wet, dark places, centipedes are fast-moving flattened-bodied predators who eat small insects after subduing them with a venomous bite. Certain kinds of centipedes can eat prey as large as mice, or small snakes or frogs. They don't usually bite humans, but if they do, the bite can be painful - though not usually dangerous.

Millipedes use their hundreds of pairs of tiny legs and rotund bodies to move in a wavelike pattern to slowly glide over surfaces. They have an impressive fossil record, having been around for 400 million years. Millipedes do not bite humans, though some species may let off a secretion that contains cyanide when provoked.
