nature notes

WHO'S WATCHING YOU?

This owl is the best known and most common species of owl in the state of Missouri. The great horned owl, nicknamed hoot owl, can be heard in late November and December when males begin to hoot, declaring a succession of three to eight hoots.



These fowls are recognized by their short ears and excellent hearing and vision. These birds have virtually no sense of smell. It's probably due to the lack of smell that the nocturnal birds quietly catch large prey, including large birds, squirrels, mice and even skunks. Their prey is the slower, weaker animals, helping make a stronger and healthier animal population.

The horned owl grows to be 22 inches in length from the tip of its bill to the tip of its tail.

These inhabitants could easily become extinct and are protected by strict laws. For those wanting to help sustain the population, nesting boxes can be added to the outdoors and use caution when using pesticides.
