nature trails

As the weather begins to cool, it's an ideal time for taking a hike on one of the many trails throughout Innsbrook! The hiking trails offer beautiful landscape, waterfalls, wildflowers and unique views. If you have some great shots taken at Innsbrook, consider entering them into the Property Owner Photo Contest. See more information on the Innsbrook Photo Contest on Page 1! Some of the trails to walk include:



- Aspen Spur Trail is 1/2 mile+ of fairly straight paths on the Aspen Spillway and meadow, providing wonderful views of waterfalls, grasslands and wildlife.
- Meadows Trail is a 1 mile+ trail that offers plenty of wildlife, colorful wildflowers and beautiful scenery. Bring your camera to capture diverse flora and fauna.
- Grendel Trail features 1+ miles of moss-covered trail and traverses around scenic 6.5-acre Lake Grendel.
- Sonnenblick Trail, at 1/2+ mile, meanders through the forest in the southeast corner of the Innsbrook property.
- Wynnbrook Trail is 1+ mile and offers a bit more of a challenge for recreational hikers.
