nature notes

CREEPY AND CRAWLY

There is only one species of tarantula in Missouri but the creepster is the largest spider in the state and known as the Missouri tarantula. These spiders often burrow in dry rocks and are nocturnal.



Although the shagginess on the body makes the spider look ferocious, the Missouri tarantulas bite is like the pain of a honeybee sting. Everyone would prefer not to be stung though and these arachnids generally stay away from people. It's best to shake your shoes and pants before putting on clothes in the morning if left in an open area, in case these or a common spider decides to take a nap inside the clothing. You're more apt to see them scurrying across a road in the fall.

The Missouri tarantula helps control the insect population, including crickets, cockroaches and other insects that approach its path.
