NATURE NOTE

Do Unseasonable Temps Affect Migration?

The mall is displaying winter clothes and the calendar reminds us that fall is on the way. But if it still feels like summer to us, how do animals and plants know it's time to head south, or finish blooming before winter sets in or begin to store fat for winter hibernation? The length of daylight, called photoperiod, is one cue that signals the change of seasons to plants and animals.

In late summer, migratory birds begin storing fat. This weight gain is triggered by hormones that are regulated by the amount of daylight the birds experience. As daylight hours decrease, more hormones are released and the birds gain weight. By the time cold weather arrives, they have stored enough fat to make long migratory flights.

So if fall weather stays balmy, you needn't worry about the hummingbirds staying too long at your feeder. The shortening days will signal them to be on their way.
