NATURE NOTE

Missouri Forest Facts



Today the state of Missouri boasts more than 14 million acres of forest land. Annual growth of forests far exceeds the amount harvested, ensuring ample forests for future generations. Healthy forests protect hillsides from erosion, filter the air and soften the extremes of weather. They also keep unwanted runoff out of our streams. At the same time, forests represent a diverse resource of plants, animals, birds and other life forms. Wildlife species such as whitetail deer, wild turkeys and wood ducks were almost extinct at the turn of the century. Wildlife conservation and habitat enhancement has resulted in flourishing populations of these and other species we now take almost for granted. Healthy forests remove about 1.8 pounds of carbon dioxide and release 1.3 pounds of oxygen into the air for each pound of wood produced. One acre of trees can remove 13 tons of dust and gases from the air every year. This means trees actually help clean the air we breathe, helping us live healthier lives. — *Missouri Department of Conservation. Photo by Andrew Thomas.*
