TAKE A TOUR OF THE INNSBROOK TRAILS! – THE MEADOWS

From babbling creeks, secret swimming holes, whimsical waterfalls and woodland animals, Innsbrook's numerous hiking trails are some of the best in the area. The trails vary in length, required exuberance, scenery, and elevation – meaning there is something for everyone to see and explore!

Innsbrook boasts a lush landscape with all-season beauty. If you've hiked a trail once and think you've seen it all – think again! Our trails offer something different in spring, summer, fall and winter – and something different in the morning, afternoon and evening!

The Meadows Trail is wonderful for exploring the diverse flora and fauna of Innsbrook along its 1.51-mile path. It takes approximately one hour to walk this trail at a leisurely, explorative pace. Bring your camera, because this path boasts plenty of wildlife, colorful wildflowers and beautiful scenery!
