# NATURE NOTE

## Walking Sticks

There's a ghost in the woods - now you see it - now you don't! The phantom? A walking stick.

Walking sticks belong to the family of phasmatidae (fas-ma-ti-dee), which is Greek for "a ghost." Walking sticks are ghostlike, for they often seem invisible when perched upon their look-alike - a twig! So complete is the mimicry that markings like the joints on twigs appear on the insect's body.

Walking sticks spend most of their day sitting motionless in trees and foliage. Any movement could ruin the insect's disguise and make it a potential meal for a hungry bird. When the wind blows, their bodies sway - as twigs would - with the trees. Just what you might expect from a ghost, walking sticks become most active in the evening. They feed on the leaves of trees, bushes and other plants.



Globally, there are thousands of species of walking sticks, but a great majority of them are restricted to tropical regions. The two types of walking sticks found in the Midwest are the northern walking stick (pictured above) and the giant walking stick. The giant walking stick is the longest insect in North America, reaching lengths of almost six inches.

Walking sticks don't sting and aren't poisonous. They are simply slow-moving, plant-eating insects. Because they seem to show up suddenly from nowhere, they've earned their ghostlike reputation.
